### 2020 SEPTIC PUMPING EXPO and AGM

Due to the precautions being taken to prevent the spread of the corona virus, it was necessary for WWNS to cancel our Septic Pumping Expo and AGM which were to be held on April 17 & 18<sup>th</sup>. The restrictions on social gathering continues to evolve but it looks like we are in it for the long haul. # **CERTIFICATION RENEWALS FOR 2020**

**If you are a Qualified Persons or a Septic Tank Cleaner** with a certification expiring at the end of May 2020, Nova Scotia Environment (NSE) will be automatically renewing your certification until September 30 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. You will receive correspondence soon on this extension.

In August of 2020, those persons with enough points under the PDP program will receive a renewal notice as usual. When you apply at that time you must submit all the materials you would normally submit for renewal, including a completed application form, proof of insurance, disposal agreements (if required), and payment. The certification will be valid from Oct 1, 2020 until May 31, 2024.

**Qualified Persons** are required to have accumulated 100 points during the 2016 to 2019 cycle in order to remain qualified to renew their Certification in 2020. <u>Point totals for this period will be available on the WWNS website until the end of April.</u>

**Septic Pumpers and Portable Restroom Operators** are required to have accumulated 50 points during the 2016 to 2019 cycle in order to remain qualified to renew their Certification in 2020. <u>Point totals for this period will also be available on the WWNS website until the end of April.</u>
