PDP Cycle

The last year in the Professional Development Process (PDP) cycle is 2024 for Qualified Persons, Septic Tank Cleaners and Portable Restroom Operators. You can login into the website www.ca to see your PDP points or you can contact Waste Water Nova Scotia office to inquire on your PDP points. You will need your membership number to login to Member Profile section of website. You can contact the WWNS office if you require your member number.

Certification renewals are issued by Nova Scotia Environment and Climate Change at the end of each PDP cycle. Qualified Persons are required to have

regional meeting and the Annual General Meeting as well as being a member of WWNS each year. Membership is 10 points, Regional Meetings are 15 points, Septic Pumper Expo is 10 points, and the AGM is 10 points. If you do not have the required points for this cycle, you can earn additional points by:

Paying membership for a year you have missed during the cycle (2020-2024).

If you missed the following meetings, recordings are available of the 2024 Septic Pumpers Expo, 2023 Annual General Meeting, 2023 Regional Meeting and 2022 Annual General Meeting. After viewing the recordings, you must submit the attendance form to be credited with the associated points. You may also submit any additional training you may have taken during the PDP period to have a point value assigned. This training should be industry related but may include occupational health and safety courses like First Aid, WHMIS, etc. Training attendance forms for additional points are to be submitted by December 28, 2024.
